



Grand Canalscape Phase II Temporary Closure of the 23rd Avenue Pedestrian Bridge

To accommodate the upcoming construction of the Grand Canalscape Phase II improvements, the pedestrian bridge over the Grand Canal at 23rd Avenue will remain temporarily closed. As part of the construction safety plan, the contractor secures the construction area with a temporary fence to keep residents and pedestrians out of the active construction zone.

Closure Details

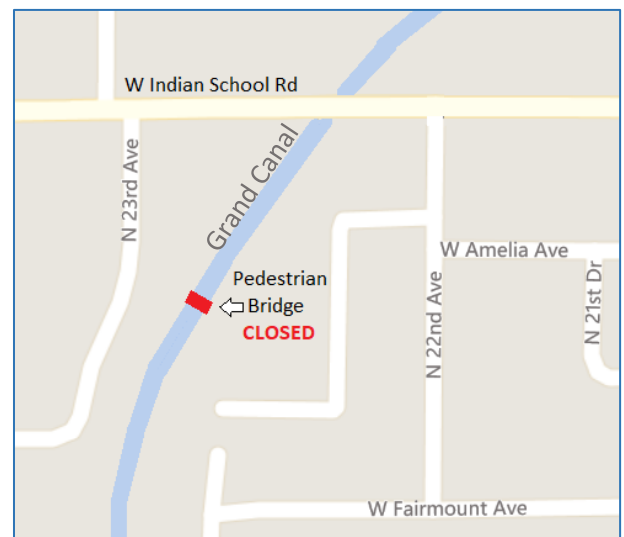
The pedestrian bridge will reopen once construction in this area is complete. Area construction is slated to be completed **spring 2019**. We apologize for any inconvenience this temporary closure may cause.

Project Details

Crews will begin by trimming and clearing vegetation, followed by preparation for the multi-use commuter path. While construction is underway, various sections of the canal trail will remain temporarily closed. Signage will be placed onsite to inform the public about these closures. The public is advised to obey all work zone signage.
